The Liberty City Council, during an emergency meeting at noon on March 13, 2020, cancelled the 2020 Liberty Jubilee due to health and safety issues associated the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Disease. The Liberty Jubilee began the same the same year as the 1986 Texas Sesquicentennial and has been an annual event for the last thirty-four (34) years. Currently there are no confirmed cases in our immediate area. However, City Council's decision was based on information provided by medical professionals and city staff regarding the public health risk to persons attending the Jubilee, vendors and city staff. Although the 2020 Liberty Jubilee has been cancelled, plans are underway for the return of the Jubilee in 2021.
