From the Liberty County Office of Emergency Management, County Judge Jay Knight and Emergency Management Coordinator Crista Beasley-Adams want to assure all Liberty County residents that Officials throughout the county are prepared in the event of a Tropical Storm to make landfall. We encourage all citizens to be alert and be prepared.

It is hurricane season, if you haven't made preparations for the season, we encourage you to prepare now! Get your emergency kits stocked up with nonperishable food items, plenty of water, medications, pet supplies, and supplies for children. Your kit should have enough supplies for the minimum of 72 hours for each family member; however, we encourage 7 days worth of supplies. Also keep your vehicles full of fuel and have some extra cash on hand. If you need tips on preparing kits please visit www.Ready.gov.
