The City of Liberty City Council held a special called meeting at noon on October 1, 2019, to approve several items related to Tropical Depression Imelda. The City Council awarded contracts associated with debris removal and debris removal monitoring. The debris removal contract was awarded to DRC Emergency Services and the debris monitoring contract was awarded to Thompson Consulting Services. Both contractors are anticipated to begin operations the week of October 8, 2019.

Also approved by City Council, were ordinances allowing for the temporary placement of recreational vehicles in the front of residences affected by Imelda and the waiver of building permit, plumbing, electrical and HVAC permit fees for repairs directly related to the recovery from Imelda. The placement of recreational vehicles and the waiver of permit fees will be effective until March 31, 2020.
