RE: Mariner South Pipeline Flaring Activities

Sunoco Pipeline L.P. will be filling its Mariner South Pipeline with Propane beginning on December 8, 2014. This pipeline runs between Mont Belvieu, Tx. and Nederland Tx south of US HWY 90. Sunoco Pipeline will be performing this operation on rotating 12 hour shifts resulting in 24 hour continuous operations until the line has been filled. There will be 3 locations where a 50' high trailer mounted flare will be used to vent nitrogen from the empty pipeline as it is being filled. When propane reaches this flare, it will ignite and burn for a short period of time while an analysis of the product is conducted. Once the sampling activities have concluded, the flare will go out and be removed from the area. It is possible during this time that you will receive calls pertaining to idled vehicles on the pipeline right of way as we track the fill pig as well as a very tall flame or a glow in the sky around the flare locations. This is a normal pipeline maintenance activity and these activities will be temporary in duration. The pipeline flaring activities will take place at Highway 146 and FM1413 near Dayton, Texas as well as on CR 1051 in the Dayton-Felicia area in Liberty County, and inside of the Sunoco Logistics Nederland Terminal in Jefferson County.
