



"BOIL WATER NOTICE"

The City of Liberty Water Department is issuing a "Boil Water Notice" due to system pressures dropping below 20 psi. This pressure drop was caused by a break in a city water main that distributes water throughout the city. The break occurred at approximately 8:00 a.m. on February 22, 2015 and pressure drops began happening at 10:00 a.m. on February 22, 2015.

The City of Liberty water system, ID#1460003, by authority of Roger R. Drews, Operations Manager, phone number 936-336-2910, has issued the boil water notice for all citizens in the **City of Liberty** as a precaution and will announce when the notice can be lifted after proper testing of the system water is accomplished.

As soon as the testing has verified no problems exist with water quality, the local news media will be notified that the boil water requirement has been lifted. This is expected to happen within 72 hours of 10:00 a.m. on, February 23, 2015.
