LIBERTY, TEXAS (OCTOBER 30, 2015) – The City of Liberty is contracting with Waste Management to collect debris from the recent flooding.

Waste Management (WM) will be in the City of Liberty beginning Wednesday, November 11, 2015 to pick up storm debris with different trucks than normal household garbage. WM will continue the regular twice a week pick up of household garbage and storm debris needs to be separated into piles as follows:

Household Garbage – Normal pickup 2 times a week

Vegetative Debris - Broken Limbs and Branches

Storm Debris - Fence Boards, rolled carpet and padding, furniture and other related items

Appliances

This is necessary to allow WM to be able to pick up the household garbage on regular scheduled pickup days. The other debris will be picked up by grapple trucks and items need to be placed on the side of the street not under power lines.
