Significant Event Outlook

Heavy Rainfall & Severe Thunderstorm Potential Tonight

Tonight's Outlook

Scattered thunderstorms will effect the northern and western counties through this evening. Later, storms have the potential to congeal into an organized area of storms and move across the area overnight.

Locations/Timing

Storms will continue developing along and northwest of a Trinity- Huntsville- Brenham line this afternoon and evening.

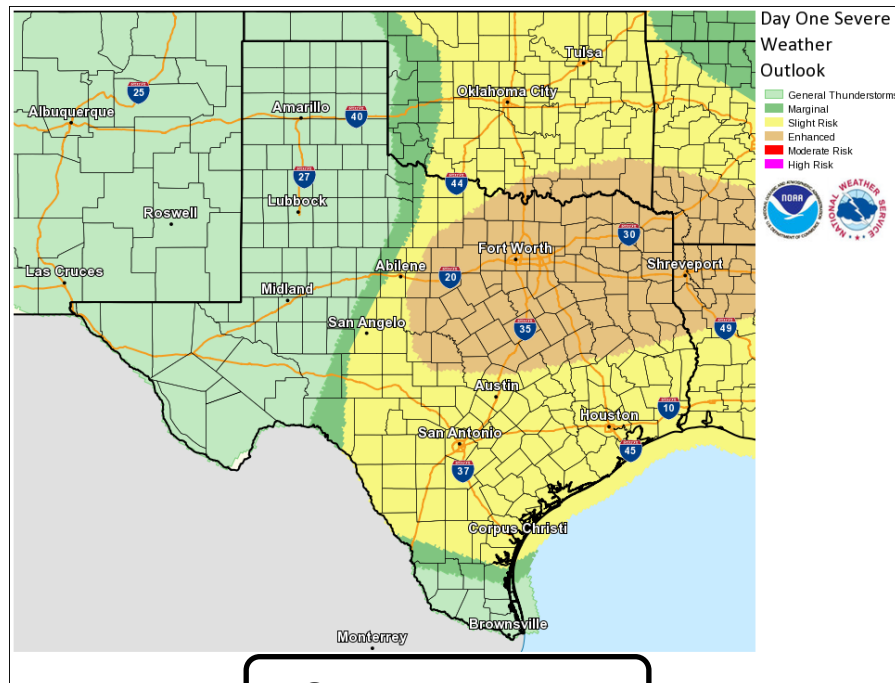
Storms should then develop/move across more of southeast TX (towards I-10) between 10p-6a.

By sunrise, thunderstorms should be confined closer to the coast and offshore.

Storms should move away from the area by late morning.

Rainfall

Widespread heavy rainfall is not expected. However, isolated 2-3" totals are possible. This would produce localized flooding impacts.



Severe Weather

Hazards (confidence)

- Frequent lightning (*Likely*)
- Locally heavy rainfall (*Likely*)
- Large hail (*Enhanced north/Slight south*)
- Isolated damaging winds (*Slight*)
- Widespread damaging winds or an isolated tornado (*Low*)
