Significant Event Outlook

Heavy Rain & Severe Thunderstorm Potential Next Week

Weekend Outlook

Rain chances will increase late this weekend over southeast TX, however the rough weather should remain to the north and west until late Sunday.

Next Week's Outlook

Strong to severe thunderstorms will return to the forecast for southeast TX by the beginning of the week. The Day 4 outlook for Monday from the Storm Prediction Center places the whole area in a SLGT risk at this time. Storm chances will remain in the forecast through the week, with heavy rainfall possible.

Rainfall

The region could see widespread, heavy rainfall to start the week. Forecast totals of 4-5+" can be expected for many locations.

Impacts/Uncertainty

Beyond 2-3 days uncertainty remains fairly high on specific impacts and timing. However, the model forecasts continue to suggest a wet and unsettled forecast for the area next week.

Flooding could become a big concern, from both flash flooding and along area rivers.
